

GOLF

- The Golf Course and Practice Range are open to Members and Invited Guests Only.
- Guests are permitted to play once per month at the posted "Guest Rate".
- All Guests must be accompanied Fri Sun, and before 11am Tue Thur. Members may reserve tee-times for "Unaccompanied" guests Monday Thursday only.
- Member Tournaments have resumed to Shotgun starts.
- · Outside tournaments have resumed.
- Cart Sharing is back in effect Twosomes may use a maximum of 1 golf cart; Threesomes and Foursomes may use of a maximum of 2 golf carts.
- Cart dividers will be provided upon request at no additional fee, as a protective barrier between players. Must be requested in advance, when booking your tee-time.
- Single rider carts will be provided upon request for an additional fee (\$5 for 9 holes, \$10 for 18 holes).
- Towels, scorecards, pencils and tees have been added back to the golf carts.
- We are requesting the Membership to leave the flagsticks in the hole while playing.
- We will continue to offer beverage cart service, weather permitting.
- The Handicap Posting station has returned.
- Bunker rakes have been placed back on the golf course.
- Flags Sticks may be removed at the player's discretion.

TENNIS/REC

- Tennis and Pickleball courts are now open for Members and <u>Accompanied Guests</u> Only.
- Please bring and use your own equipment.
- Members should be respectful of others waiting to play and relinquish the court after 90 minutes if other Members are waiting.
- The water cooler has been removed. Please bring your own water bottles and then take them home.
- Appropriate apparel and regulation tennis shoes are required for play on the Tennis and Rec. Courts.

PLAYGROUND

- The Playground is now open under "Use at Your Own Risk" protocol. By allowing your kids to use the playground, you assume all risks associated with the COVID-19 virus.
- NO PETS ALLOWED within the fenced-in play area, which is designated only for
 parents to bring their CHILDREN to play on the playground equipment supplied for their
 enjoyment. NO PETS will assure that the playground remains safe and clean.
- If you choose to use the playground, we recommend following the guidelines listed below:
 - Practice social distancing of 6 feet or more from individuals that do not live in your household;
 - Only interact with people in your household;
 - Wear a facemask at all times while on the playground (do not use on children under two years old, people with difficulty breathing, or people who cannot remove the mask themselves);

 - Consider bringing your own disinfecting wipes to disinfect hand-hold surfaces prior to play.







Practice Range

Please note: The driving range will close at 4:00pm on Sunday & Thursday and will open at 8:30am on Monday and Friday to accommodate weekly maintenance.

During the winter, the range will be "mats only" during the week. The grass will be used on weekends, weather permitting. This will help maintain the quality of the turf during the slower growing season.

Also, we would like to remind our members that range balls are NOT to be removed from the driving range or used on the golf course, so we may keep them in circulation for the enjoyment of all members and guests. Thanks!

Club Repair in 2022

Winter Golf Club Tune Up: winter is the time to make sure your clubs get tuned up for the upcoming golf season! We offer re-gripping and loft and lie adjustments services on site. Drop your set of clubs off at the proshop and let our staff evaluate your current set and suggest which services might benefit your game. If you re-grip 10 or more clubs, we will check and adjust the loft and lie for your clubs for \$1 per Club!

The golf shop has expanded club repair services beyond re-gripping. We now offer full club repair services to include re-shafting, loft & lie adjustments and shaft extensions and trimming.



Instruction Corner

Many people struggle to make a consistent strike in chipping. The big thing is to be sure the low point of your swing—where the club hits the ground—comes after you contact the ball.

Try this: (1) Set more weight on your front foot and maintain that position through impact; (2) Rotate your shoulders through the shot. Some golfers rock the shoulders like a seesaw. When the front shoulder rocks up on the downswing, the spine tips away from the target and the low point shifts back. So, stay forward and turn that shoulder open. You'll chip it great!

Now is the time to work on your game, as the season kicks off. We offer private instruction at a fee of \$50 per lesson. Book a series of 3 private lessons for \$125 or a



series of 5 private lessons for \$200. Group lessons, clinics and playing lessons also offered.

Course Update

January weather was all over the place for us here in our region. We went from 80degree days first part of the month to subfreezing temperatures and rain middle to end of the month. The course has held up well given all the windy days and scattered debris

litter. On Jan 3rd we had wind gust up to 60 mph which in turn cause several trees to fall, luckily of them impacted play on the golf course. Maintenance was able to get those cleaned up in a timely manner. Being that we are still short staffed it may take us a little longer to get

all the smaller debris cleaned up, especially when we continue to receive these timely rains that do not allow us to put equipment out on the fairways.

We have continued our fairway and lowlying area topdressing program to help with moisture management. Typically, we order around twenty-five tons of sand at a time to apply to these areas, over time we will build. a sand layer that will help with drainage in

> these lower lying and around areas catch basins. We will not see immediate results as this is a big picture project.

> Greens continue to be in great shape and are holding up nicely through the up and down weather we have had. We look forward to getting through February and into March for

some nice spring weather so we can start our early season turf cultural practices.

As always please remember to fill your divots and fix your ball marks!

FACILITY USE

The Coosaw Creek Country Club amenities include the Swimming Pool and Pavilion, Tennis Courts, Basketball Court, Golf Course and Clubhouse. We encourage all of our members to take advantage of the various fun activities and facilities available to them. To assure a safe and enjoyable and safe experience for all it is important to note the following guidelines:

18 HOLE PAR 71 ARTHUR HILLS CHAMPIONSHIP GOLF COURSE - Winds through beautiful low country wooded wetlands surrounded by community homes. Golf Pro Shop hours are 7AM-7PM everyday.

During golf play hours of 7AM to dusk only Pro Shop authorized golfers and the Club maintenance staff are allowed on the course and cart paths.

Personal golf carts, skate boards, bicycles or other personal motorized vehicles are not permitted on the course or cart paths at anytime.

Dog walkers, permitted before or after golf hours, must carry and use pooper scoopers and keep pets off of tees, fairways, greens and bunkers.

The course is open for public play daily, but all play must be approved by the proshop prior to beginning on the course.

Any unapproved play, practice or abuse observed on the course may result in suspension of Club privileges and/or fines.

GOLF PRACTICE FACILITY

The Practice Areas are open during normal Golf Course hours except for posted regularly scheduled maintenance times. Practice areas include the Driving Range, Chipping Green, Practice Sand Bunker, Putting Green and teaching area.

Teaching is provided exclusively by the Coosaw Creek Professional Golf Staff.

All practice must be approved by the Pro Shop staff.

Range balls and bags are the property of Coosaw Creek Country Club and shall not be removed from club property. Proper Attire is the same as for the Golf Course.

COOSAW CREEK COUNTRY CLUBHOUSE is Coosaw Creek's community center featuring full service dining, Bar, Meeting Rooms and Pro Shop. In addition to supporting the many social functions of the Members, the Clubhouse banquet facilities are available to Members and the public for meetings, parties, weddings and other celebrations. Take-out and call ahead service is also available.

CLUB ATTIRE

Quality denim or golf shorts are allowed in the clubhouse unless specified otherwise for special events. For all evening dining events after 5pm, men must wear a collared shirt and caps are not allowed in the dining room. Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times. Cover ups must be worn over Swim attire.

TENNIS/REC COURTS

Two regulation Plexipave lighted tennis courts and a basketball court are available to Members only:

Tennis courts are strictly reserved for tennis.

Tennis play is on a first come, first served basis until 11:00pm

Appropriate apparel and regulation tennis shoes are required for play on the tennis courts.

Shirts must be worn at all times on the Basketball Court which is a multi function surface that can be used for any suitable purpose.

SWIMMING POOLS

Open from Memorial Day Weekend until Labor Day Weekend, the Swimming Pool is staffed with lifeguards during published hours and is available for open swim (at your own risk) when lifeguards are not present.

Please observe and follow all rules posted in the pool area. All instructions from pool staff and/or lifeguards must be obeyed.

All Food or Beverages must be purchased from the Club, unless prior approval has been obtained from the General Manager.

Pool closes at 9:00 PM except for special events.

PLAYGROUND



A sand filled area equipped with swings, slides and other playground equipment is available and located next to the Pool Pavilion –For safety any child under 9 years old must be supervised by an adult.

Playground closes at 9:00 PM

NO PETS ALLOWED



PONDS

Coosaw Creek's beautiful ponds have been stocked with fish - but beware of snakes, alligators and other

wildlife.

Please DO NOT FEED THE GEESE

The course ponds are part of a larger low country wooded wetland area. Please respect this incredible asset and avoid contaminating it with any foreign materials or liquids.

Fishing is allowed only from the bank and only in designated areas. These areas have been selected to ensure that people fishing are not in the normal flight of golf balls and that ponds can be approached without crossing the course or using the cart paths. They are located:

- POND BEHIND THE PLAYGROUND -Approach from McChune Court
- HOLE 15 Approach from Arthur Hills Circle
- HOLE 16 Approach from Club Course Drive
- HOLE 17 Approach from Power Line Break Fish in course ponds are for "catch and release" and not for consumption – a major disappointment to our chef!



These guidelines are established to ensure a positive experience for all Members and guests who use the facilities. Enforcement is the responsibility of all members and staff of the Club. A polite reminder is usually sufficient, but should it become necessary to report any violation please call the Pro-Shop or the Club General Manager.
