# Course News



## FERTILIZER APPLICATION

**SUNDAY, APRIL 3RD**

Due to weather issues, we were forced to reschedule the application of organic fertilizer on the golf course. April 3rd was the only available make-up date from our vendor. The first tee-time will be moved to 8:30am. We apologize for any inconvenience!

## PRACTICE FACILITY RENOVATION

**BEGINNING ON MONDAY, APRIL 4TH**

Renovation work will begin on Monday, April 4th. The practice range and short game area will be closed until the project and grow-in are completed (target date of June 1, depending on weather).

We will open a "WARM-UP" area at the site of the current members tee, as soon as project work allows. However, due to limitations on space, **we will limit use to 1 BAG of range balls** for the purpose of warming up prior to your round. Please be respectful to your fellow members by not abusing this rule!

## PRACTICE FACILITY WORK

We will be increasing the size of the practice tee and improving the short game area. The project will include doubling the size of the existing practice tee reshaping and regrassing the short game area to include a 360 degree hitting area and regrassing the short game green with Mini-Verde grass (which is the same grass used on our course greens). We will also be installing drainage for the short game green and a new irrigation system for the practice area. Lastly, we will implement and utilize the AccuRange app which will show GPS distances to all targets on the range and short game area.



We will continue to use the contracted services of Goose Busters, a humane method to deter our local geese population, utilizing trained Border Collie dogs. Please be aware that you will see the dogs and their handlers on the golf course throughout the year.

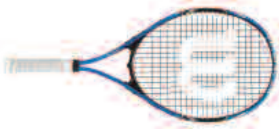
## Course News

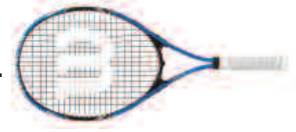
