


News From The Golf Shop



Renovation work is in progress! The project will include 4 phases - site prep, irrigation, sodding/grassing and grow-in. We are currently still in the site prep phase which consists of tilling and stripping the "old" grass, shaping/grading the new hitting areas, installing drainage, shelling out the chipping green and then laser leveling of all areas to specifications. This is the most time consuming portion of the project. So far we have added 25 truck loads of soil and we are into the laser leveling portion. We anticipate completing this phase by the end of the week.

In the next phase we will install irrigation which will include new underground pipe, irrigation heads and communication controller. Once this phase begins it will take about 4-5 days to complete the installation and then we will be ready to move onto grassing!







For the grassing phase, we plan to truck in approximately 74,000 square feet of "419" Bermuda sod (grass used on our fairways and tees) for the hitting areas and another 6,000 square

feet of Mini-Verde sod (grass used on our greens) for the chipping green. We will also install the mats at the back of the range during this phase of the project. And we are estimating another week of work for the grassing phase.

The final phase will be the grow-in. We will use several products to help speed up the process of getting the turf tacked down and filled-in. 1st we will use a generic 10-10-10 fertilizer and dolimitic lime that we will put down before the turf is installed, this will help get nutrients into the soil to create a good growing medium. Typical high nitrogen fertilizers can cause the PH to climb and by putting down lime we can bring those Once grassed, we will be numbers down. applying ammonium sulfate 21-0-0 and an organic 5-3-0 fertilizer to promote rooting and seam fill in. Of course with any grow in we must apply liberal amounts of topdressing sand to help get everything smooth, the process of topdressing the range tee and short game area will continue regularly throughout the growing season.

Once the project is complete we will have a practice tee roughly 3 times larger than the size of the previous tee and a short game practice area which will feature a 360 degree hitting area and bunker. We currently are targeting a re-opening date of June 1, depending on weather!

Range Warm-Up Area

A "WARM-UP" area at the site of the current members tee is open. However, due to limitations on space we are limiting use to 1 BAG of range balls per member. Please be respectful to your fellow members by not abusing this rule!

AccuRange & AccuCaddie Apps

Once the Practice Facility re-opens, we will utilize the AccuRange app which will show GPS distances to all targets on the range and short game area from your smart phone.

We will also implement and utilize the AccuCaddie app which will show a GPS map of the golf course with distances from your location including pin locations (similar to the Visage screen on our golf carts). This will be great for our members who prefer to walk and when carts are restricted to Cart Path only.

Course Conditions

March and April nighttime temps have been lower than in years past, which have slowed our spring grass growth and green-up of roughs, fairways and greens. As soon as we start to get higher temperatures the greens will start to pop and fill-in allowing us to start back with our regular cultural practices. We look for what's called the "145 degree rule". If you take the high temp for the day and add it to the low temp for the day, if they equal 145 (or higher) for 5 days or more, our Bermuda grass will be growing.

We are still currently doing the following on the greens:

- Mowing daily @.130" (with groomers)
- Rolling weekly
- Spraying liquid fertilizer weekly (including a multitude of liquids plus potassium nitrate and calcium nitrate on an every other week rotation)
 - Watering nightly during dry spells

And, On Monday, May 2 we will be verticutting and topdressing as well as applying a granular fertilizer (1/2lb Nitrogen) to spur the greens growth. Until we get the temperatures up where we need, we will continue to do our best. Sometimes Mother Nature just doesn't want to cooperate!
